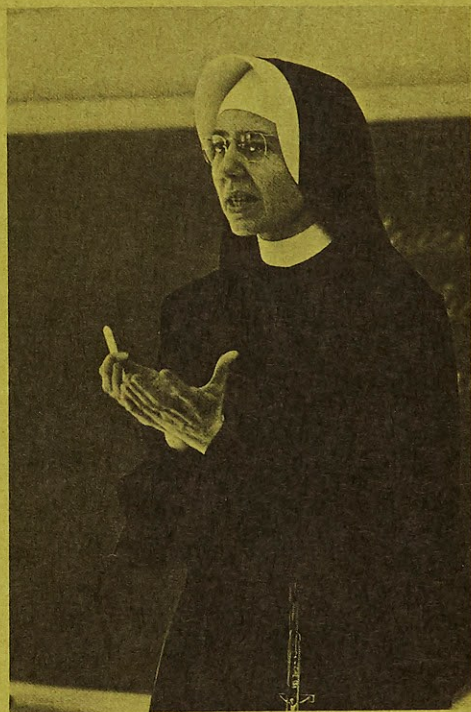

themselves and did not escape the price.

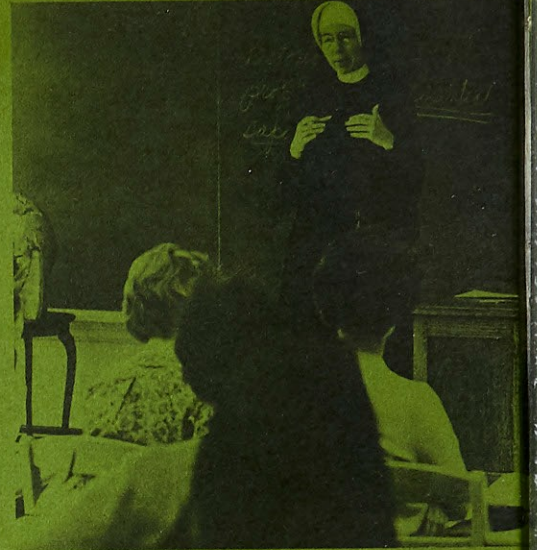
Man's remembered if he burn and die.

the young girl whose only fault was faith.

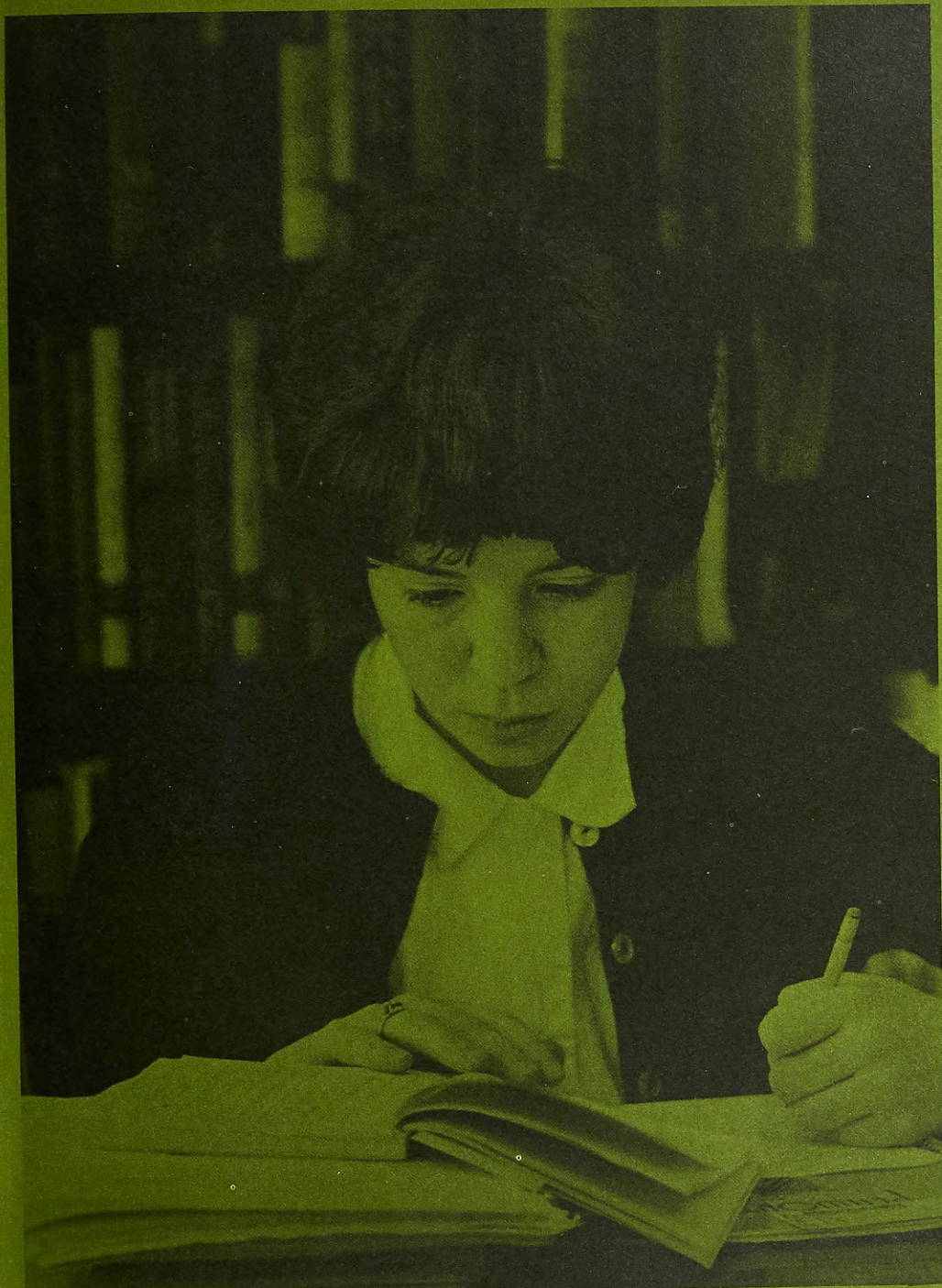
He late who reared magnificent

life as efficiently as death.

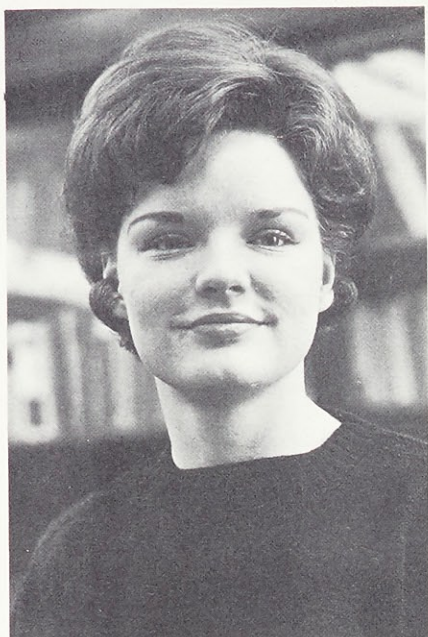
