"Goodbye, My Fancy"

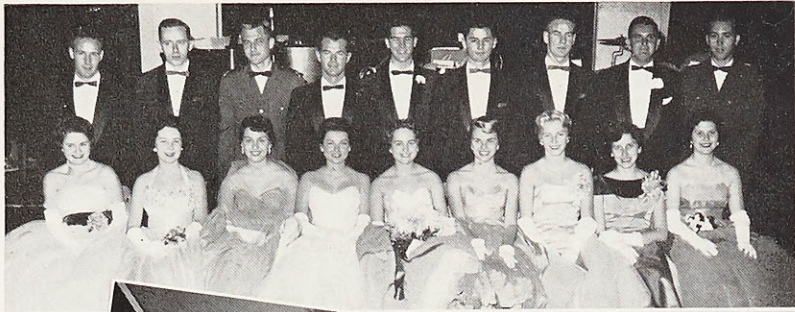


"Goodbye, My Fancy", a romantic comedy by Fay Kanin was the fall production of The Loretto Players.

CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS

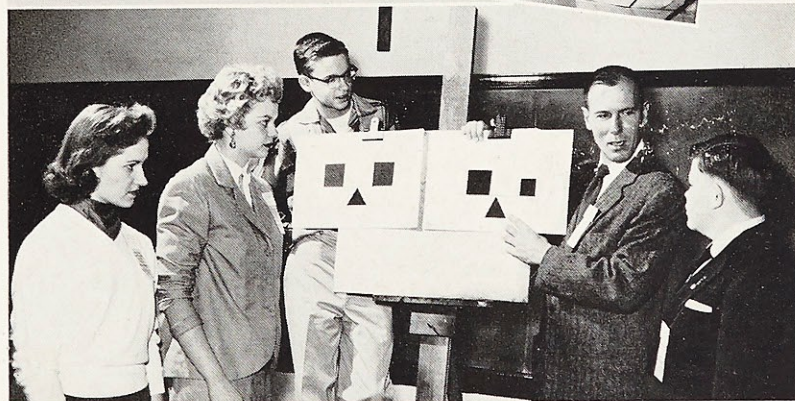
Traditionally, the Junior Class prepares the school for Christmas by means of their decorations and banquet. This year the theme of these was the Christmas liturgy.

FATHER-DAUGHTER BANQUET

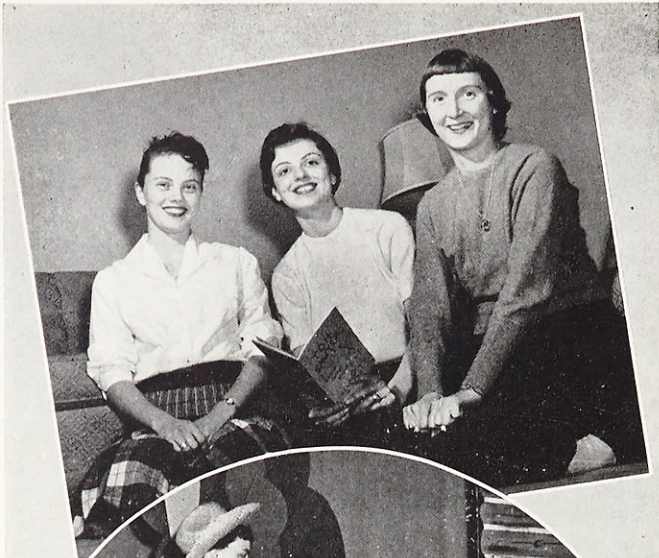
The Chase Hotel was the scene of the largest Father-Daughter Banquet in Webster College history. It took place on February 18, bringing the Musical Weekend to a close.
